## 2018-2019 BAC Series Finals Rules

1. The three bowlers entering the Series Finals with the greatest number of tournament series points will receive free entry into the Series Finals.
2. Those participating in the Series Finals will draw their lane assignments on the day of the event.
3. All participants will complete in a preliminary round consisting of five games.
4. At the conclusion of each game bowlers will move one pair of lanes to their right.
5. All participants will receive handicap as outlined in the tournament series rules.
6. The participants with the top eight five-game totals (5-game scratch score plus handicap) will qualify for the championship round.
7. All ties for seeding will be resolved by comparing the highest single scratch game of the bowlers involved except when the tie determines which bowlers qualify for the championship round.
8. When a tie for qualification to the championship round occurs, all tied bowlers will complete in a two-frame roll-off with $1 / 5$ of their single game handicaps applied.
9. The championship round will consist of an eight-player, single elimination bracket.
10. All championship round matches will consist of one game.
11. The better-seeded bowler will have the option to choose bowling order.
12. Surviving bowlers will be "reseeded" after each bracket round so the best remaining seed bowls the worst remaining seed.
13. Any ties in the championship round will be resolved with a two-frame roll-off with bowlers receiving $1 / 5$ of their single game handicaps.
