2018-2019 BAC Series Finals Rules

- 1. The three bowlers entering the Series Finals with the greatest number of tournament series points will receive free entry into the Series Finals.
- 2. Those participating in the Series Finals will draw their lane assignments on the day of the event.
- 3. All participants will complete in a preliminary round consisting of five games.
- 4. At the conclusion of each game bowlers will move one pair of lanes to their right.
- 5. All participants will receive handicap as outlined in the tournament series rules.
- 6. The participants with the top eight five-game totals (5-game scratch score plus handicap) will qualify for the championship round.
- 7. All ties for seeding will be resolved by comparing the highest single scratch game of the bowlers involved except when the tie determines which bowlers qualify for the championship round.
- 8. When a tie for qualification to the championship round occurs, all tied bowlers will complete in a two-frame roll-off with 1/5 of their single game handicaps applied.
- 9. The championship round will consist of an eight-player, single elimination bracket.
- 10. All championship round matches will consist of one game.
- 11. The better-seeded bowler will have the option to choose bowling order.
- 12. Surviving bowlers will be "reseeded" after each bracket round so the best remaining seed bowls the worst remaining seed.
- 13. Any ties in the championship round will be resolved with a two-frame roll-off with bowlers receiving 1/5 of their single game handicaps.
